Our goal is to provide what every child is entitled to
— the hope for a better future.

The Beth Dillinger Foundation is a not-for-profit 501(c)(3) corporation that provides support and education to boys and girls in need. Three different means of support include the Beth Dillinger Scholarship Fund, a scholarship endowment available to boys and girls who wish to continue their education, but do not have the funds to achieve that goal; Beth's Closet at PACE Center for Girls in Pinellas County, Florida; and the Hope Chest clothes closet located in the Public Defender's Office in Clearwater and New Port Richey.

Beth's Closet is located at PACE Center for Girls in Pinellas Park, Florida. This clothes closet is both a source of necessity and fun for the girls at PACE, who are at risk girls ranging in age from twelve to eighteen. Inside Beth's Closet the girls can find dresses, jeans, T-shirts, blouses, skirts, pajamas, shoes, jewelry, purses and just about anything else a teenage girl needs. We also have “closet days” centered around a holiday theme where the girls can choose two items to take home, along with a special gift for that particular day.



Hope Chest clothes closet is located in the Public Defender's Office in both Clearwater and New Port Richey. This clothes closet serves young, abused, neglected or abandoned children, ages twelve to eighteen, who are part of the Public Defender Crossover Program or are under the jurisdiction of the Guardian ad litem's office. Many of these young people are taken from their homes or other abusive environments with only the clothes on their backs. The HOPE CHEST provides basic necessities such as personal hygiene items, shoes, clothing, undergarments, pajamas, bedding, books and bus passes which help to make their lives more functional.
